# **Practical information**

### **Platform**

- 1. In this booklet you can find all the information about the Introduction Week. For the latest updates make sure to **always check the Introduction Week Platform**.
- 2. In your confirmation e-mail, you received your **personal** sign in information for the Introduction Week. You can use this information to sign into the online platform that will be used for all the online events during this week.
- 3. You can find a link to the online platform on the Introduction Week page on the ESN Groningen website (www.esn-groningen.nl).
- 4. On each individual day, links will be posted on the platform through which you can join the online events.

### Introduction Week

- 1. During all ESN events, the use of drugs is prohibited.
- **BE AWARE:** Breaking this rule will lead to removal from the entire Introduction Week.
- 2. The consumption of alcohol during physical events of the Introduction Week is prohibited.

# COVID-19

Due to COVID-19, the ESN Introduction Week will look a bit different compared to previous editions. We ask you to take all regulations implemented by the Dutch government regarding COVID-19 seriously and *follow them at all times*. Not doing so will result in removal from the entire Introduction Week programme.

- 1. Keep 1,5 metres distance from everyone at all times.
- 2. If you have any health complaints, like a fever, a cough, sneezing, sudden loss of taste and smell, stay home and be tested immediately!
- 3. Taking a corona test in the Netherlands is free of charge. Call 0800-1202 to make an appointment or go to www.government.nl/ for more information.
- 4. Wash/disinfect your hands as often as possible and do not shake hands with other people.
- 5. We work with strict time slots, so we ask you to **not come to events too early or too late**. This way everyone will be able to keep the 1.5m distance.
- 6. It is prohibited to consume alcoholic beverages during physical activities of the ESN Introduction Week
- 7. Activities related to the Introduction Weeks by student organisations must end at 22:00.
- 8. The number of visitors that people can receive at home is limited to 6.


